Queniborough Primary School uses the Language Angels scheme of work and resources to ensure we offer a relevant, broad, vibrant and ambitious foreign languages curriculum that will inspire and excite our pupils using a wide variety of topics and themes. All pupils will be expected to achieve their full potential by encouraging high expectations and excellent standards in their foreign language learning - the ultimate aim being that pupils will feel willing and able to continue studying languages beyond key stage 2. The four key language learning skills; **listening, speaking, reading and writing** will be taught and all necessary **grammar** will be covered in an age-appropriate way across the primary phase. This will enable pupils to use and apply their learning in a variety of contexts, laying down solid foundations for future language learning.



French is taught for approximately half an hour each week although this may be blocked together

- We are currently exploring the possibility of establishing regular residential trips for our Year 6 children to France so that they can practice their spoken French skills in a real life context.

French is taught in a whole-class setting by the class teacher and is therefore not reliant on one key member of staff. Teachers plan their lessons using the Language Angels scheme of work and can supplement this with their own ideas and experience

- Our children enjoy French lessons as they are highly interactive. The leave KS2 equipped and confident to move onto the Key Stage 3 program of study at their secondary school.

We encourage, where appropriate, class assemblies and presentations in French. Where appropriate cross-curricular links are made to other subjects to knit together various areas of the curriculum.
